"The fifth grade is a perfect time to introduce the *Get Fit* concepts," said Alicia Polston, a health education specialist at the CHEC. "What kids learn in this program will hopefully lead to better choices and good habits in middle school, and for the rest of their lives."

Each child received a *Get Fit* workbook that included not only a place to track their daily "steps," but also a place to list the fruits and vegetables they ate.

"The nutrition side of the program was just as important as the fitness side," said Matt Drahn, the hospital's employee fitness and wellness coordinator. "Our goal was to change the mindset ... this isn't a diet, it's a series of small changes that make up life changes."

When asked if leading the *Get Fit* program had any impact on her life, Meisenheimer said, "I'm more apt to keep moving because I've seen the motivation and benefits with my students. I know every step leads to increased fitness."

While the program is called *Get Fit*, and will surely start kids on the road to better health, it may also lead to better classroom behavior, and maybe even a heightened interest in academics, too.

## Get Fit Salem

Imagine being 10 years old, sluggish and out of shape, being able to proudly declare: "This program changed my life." "I'm enjoying exercise for the first time." And "I'm spending more time playing basketball with my family."

Those statements came from three of 1,660 students who took part in the Salem Hospital Foundation-funded *Get Fit Salem* program last year. A \$27,000 grant from the Foundation provided pedometers and journals for fifth graders in local Title 1 schools.

"Many districts have been forced to reduce or cut their PE programs due to budget constraints," said Ronnie Meisenheimer, a Keizer Elementary School PE teacher. "This makes it difficult for students to get the recommended 150 minutes of moderate to vigorous physical activity each school week."

The 12-week *Get Fit* program, coordinated through the hospital's Community Health Education Center (CHEC), coached students on increasing activity and improving their diet. But it can also impact other areas of students' lives.

"Oregon's quest to drive academics has taken its toll on fitness," said Marigay Schoop, lead PE teacher for the Salem-Keizer School District. "Getting blood to the brain is a significant factor in brain activity and learning."

According to Oregon's Department of Human Services, 25 percent of eighth graders are at risk of obesity. Between 2001 and 2007, the



## Palliative Care

Barbara was a little frustrated. Her cancer responded to surgery and chemotherapy. However, side effects kept her coming back to the hospital. She received lots of advice from many different people, and that was confusing.

To pull all the pieces of the puzzle together, Barbara's oncologist referred her to the hospital's palliative care team.



Palliative care is a medical specialty that helps seriously ill patients find relief from the symptoms of their disease. The care teams include physicians, nurses, social workers and chaplains, with support from dietitians, physical therapists, pharmacists and complimentary medicine practitioners. Together they help patients and families sort through the maze of information.

Initially, Salem Health's palliative care program will see patients through the Salem Cancer Institute.

"When I was in the hospital, so many people came in my room who wanted to help," said Barbara. "They took such good care of me, and gave my family and I excellent resource materials."

An \$84,000 grant from the Salem Hospital Foundation is funding a clinical nurse educator for the program, as well as providing materials that give patients and families new ideas for managing serious chronic illnesses.

"For Salem Hospital to be able to offer palliative care services to our community, the assistance provided by the Salem Hospital Foundation has been absolutely essential. Without their support, this service may not have become a reality," said Becky Ruppert, RN, MS, palliative care nurse. ## New Ultrasound Equipment

Keeping pace with today's technology is a challenge. But thanks to support from the Salem Hospital Foundation, pregnant mothers who may have complications now have access to a new ultrasound machine. This machine gives care providers a clear picture of the fetus, and allows them to do diagnostic work-ups, testing and even surgery before birth if necessary to care for the unborn child.

Clear pictures of what is happening to the fetus before delivery helps the health care team plan and care for mother and child.

The Foundation provided \$75,000 toward the \$250,000 purchase of the premium ultrasound machine.

The King Staff Library at the CHEC provides hospital staff with a first-class collection of print and electronic resources.



Since the scholarship program began over 40 years ago, the Salem Hospital Foundation has awarded over \$1.3 million to students in our community pursuing careers in the health care field. In 2009, 88 students received scholarships totaling \$142,000.



## A Lifetime of Learning

She's gone back to college, joined the local volunteer fire department, loves her career path – medicine – and is head over heels about being a wife and mother of four. Listening to Amanda talk, you can hear that she's passionate about many things.

As a second-year recipient of the Salem Hospital Foundation's Emmons Nursing Scholarship, Amanda is attending Linfield College's School of Nursing in Portland.

"The Foundation scholarship award has been huge for us," said Amanda. "My husband works full time, and he and my sister and dad help tremendously with the kids. Having financial support relieves me of some worries," said Amanda.

Before deciding to go back to college, Amanda worked as a certified medical assistant at Salem Clinic for seven years. But she wanted to do more with her passion to enrich lives. "I wanted more responsibility ... to be involved more in patient's lives," she said.

She joined the Mt. Angel Volunteer Fire Department to get more trauma care experience, which "helps me think of diagnoses from a holistic perspective, not just a list of unrelated vital signs," she said.

Mark Fischl, M.D., who supervised Amanda while she worked at Salem Clinic, recalled an instance where Amanda took the meaning of being involved in a patient's life to a new level.

An elderly patient was telling Dr. Fischl how much he missed eating red meat because his wife wasn't able to cook anymore.

Amanda recalled that, "My husband and I were just married, and I was thawing out prime rib we'd saved from our reception. So, I took some of it to the gentleman. His smile made all the hard things I do worthwhile," she said.

With 18 months of nursing school left, Amanda's already thinking about the kind of care she'd like to practice.

"People who are sick are emotionally as well as physically hurting. If I can support patients in their emotional health, their physical health will improve even faster," she said. "Getting to treat and educate people every day, I wake up each morning wanting to go to school and work."



## Counting on Employee Support

Joanne Vietty, physical therapist, worked at Salem Hospital for 31 years in various inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation areas before retiring in December of 2009. She is enjoying spending more time with her grandchildren, and looking forward to exploring other parts of the world including places like England, Australia and Italy.

### *Why do you support the Salem Hospital Foundation?*

I have so much to be thankful for, and I feel it's important to give back especially in these times when there are so many needs to be met. I realize that working for the hospital and doing my best in terms of my job is one way to give, but I also want to be supportive of a variety of programs and services, and a wonderful way to do that is through the Foundation. The Foundation knows about the needs of different hospital programs and services, so by giving to the Foundation, I know that my gifts will be put to good use helping someone, somewhere, that I may not even know about.

### *What do you hope to accomplish with your gifts?*

For instance, the Foundation funded a NuStep machine that at the time was a state-of-the-art piece of equipment


for patients undergoing physical rehabilitation on their legs. Another example is Easy Street. The Foundation funded part of this replica of a city street that includes a grocery store, curbs, a car, and kitchen that staff at the regional rehabilitation center use with patients on an ongoing basis to practice activities of daily living that help patients regain their independence in performing everyday tasks.

### *What message do you have for employees considering making a gift to the Foundation?*

I would encourage everyone to give what they can. Monthly payroll deductions are such an easy way to give throughout the year, unlike a larger one-time gift which can seem unmanageable. 
