From the CHAIR

DO YOU REMEMBER getting an allowance growing up, and figuring out how you wanted to spend it? My husband and I pay our children an allowance each week. Although they get a portion for spending, we require them to set aside a portion for charity. When they wonder what their small amount can offer a charity, I tell them every little bit can make a difference. And I have seen that first hand at the Salem Hospital Foundation.

Most tax-deductible donations made to the Foundation are not huge amounts. But, like the small gifts our children make to charity each week, every one of your contributions helps meet the Foundation's goals. As stewards of that investment, the Foundation board members and staff take great care leveraging contributions into high-quality, health projects and initiatives.

Consider how important it is, for example, to provide a young mother in need with a free infant car seat when she leaves the hospital. Or, teddy bears for frightened children who come to the Emergency Department. Or scholarships for students. Or computers in patient rooms so staff have better access to track care. While not huge investments, they are, nonetheless, hugely important to the people receiving them.

At the other end of the spectrum, the Foundation provided funding for the Community Health Education Center. Your donations also helped purchase expensive surgical equipment: the daVinci surgical robot, and the Trilogy linear accelerator

that provides precise radiation treatment for cancer patients. The millions spent on less invasive surgical technology helps patients heal faster. And the "return on investment" is priceless, as patients more quickly regain their health while minimizing lost time and resources.

As owners of a small business, we apply the "every little thing can make a difference" principle in how we do business. During the five years that I've been involved with the Foundation, it's been gratifying to see those same concerns for efficiency at work at Salem Hospital.

While our not-for-profit hospital strives to improve care and reduce costs, its reliance on Foundation funding has increased. All of us are working to assure that everyone in our community has access to the same quality care and services.

I've been touched by your generosity to the Foundation in support of our local hospital. Whether you make the Foundation a beneficiary in your estate plan, donate \$25, \$2,500, or somewhere in between, your vote of confidence in our careful investment of your donation is inspiring to me. A Lifetime of Learning and SHARING

FROM HER LIVING ROOM, Lori Dahlberg can see the farmhouse she grew up in on Delaney Road, in Turner. Her parents’ 200-acre dairy farm was nearly self-sufficient. Thoughts of sufficiency—and her own struggle with cancer—are part of the reason she and her husband have made a significant donation to cancer education through the Salem Hospital Foundation.

Lori met her husband John in the 1960s. He was a high school teacher, and she was the principal’s secretary. They didn’t marry until 1984, after meeting again at Boise State, where she was getting a master’s degree in teaching, and he was a professor. In the interim, he received his Ph.D. from the University of Oregon.

The couple are involved with various organizations including Salem Hospital, Our Savior’s Lutheran Church and the Turner Fire Department, where John volunteers. In 2006, those volunteers saved Lori’s life.

She had recently been diagnosed with multiple myeloma, a bone marrow cancer. “John had gone to Safeway, and I was still in bed,” Lori explained. At 8:40 a.m. on Mother’s Day, the fire department paramedics were at the door, just checking in. Had they not arrived, Lori would have died before John got home. Severe anemia and an immune system deficiency caused by the cancer triggered a blood pressure drop and pulmonary embolism that could have been fatal.

Four years later, Lori reports that, “Early detection really helps. The numbers I just got back from lab tests are the best ever.”

The couple decided to name the Salem Hospital Foundation in their will, and in order to help others, have made significant gifts to the Foundation designated for the Salem Cancer Institute.

“It was difficult the first few days after my diagnosis, because we didn’t have access to credible and reliable information about this condition,” Lori said. “People with diagnoses have so much to struggle with,” John added. “We’re hoping our contribution will fill some of the informational void that we experienced.”

“John and I believe strongly in supporting organizations that have the greatest community impact,” Lori said. “Our gift is a ‘thanks’ for the Foundation’s vision and leadership. They can effectively leverage our dollars for healing better than we could on our own.”

FOR SOME PEOPLE, post-traumatic stress becomes a lifelong scar. But for Jennifer Pond, she turned a horrifying childhood event into a career path.

On a camping trip with her family, six-year-old Jennifer tripped and fell into the campfire, severely burning her hands and knees. While she recovered fully without skin grafts, she nonetheless has become an organ donor advocate, volunteering at various health fairs providing information about the value of organ donation.

She is also a wife, a mother of two young daughters, a certified nursing assistant on the hospital's Neuro-Trauma Care Unit, a nursing student, and the recipient of a Salem Hospital Foundation nursing scholarship.

"Salem Hospital has been the best employer I've ever had," said Jennifer. "Because I believe so strongly in community support for our healthcare institutions, I've donated to the Foundation since I started working at the hospital."

Jennifer is in her final year of nursing school in the OHSU program located on the Western Oregon University campus in Monmouth.

"The Foundation scholarship has been tremendously valuable, and a great support in helping me achieve my nursing degree," said Jennifer.

"Going to school, working and raising a family is a lot to juggle, so I'm very grateful for the financial help the Foundation provided," she continued.

Beyond nursing, Jennifer also has an interest (and a degree) in Spanish. "When I was in the hospital having my daughters, I saw a Latina woman also in labor, and she couldn't communicate with the staff. I realized how much more I could accomplish being proficient in Spanish along with my nursing career," she added.

According to Jennifer, while the financial support from the Foundation has been a huge gift, she wouldn't have been able to continue her education without the help of her family.

"The patience and support I've received from my husband Bret has kept me going. It's really what has allowed me to be a wife, mother, student, employee and volunteer. And I look forward to continuing those roles once I graduate."

Counting on Employee SUPPORT

DOUG MOLLERSTUEN has worked at Salem Hospital since 1986. He started in the Ophthalmology Department taking photos of patients' eyes for physicians. Later he worked in audio visual, where he produced medical photos and slides. He is currently a systems analyst in information services. When he's not working, he volunteers at the Dallas Retirement Village helping residents with their computer issues, and pushing wheelchairs.

What made you decide to make your first gift to the Foundation over six years ago?

I just remember thinking that the Foundation does some really cool things, and I wanted to be a part of that. I'm reminded of just how cool it is every time I look at the Community Health Education Center (CHEC). Now that is impressive!

I also remember that when I first started working at the hospital over 20 years ago, hospital staff encouraged me, and took an interest in my career path. I hope that in some small way by supporting the Foundation and the scholarships they provide for students, I'm giving back a little of that encouragement.

What do you hope to accomplish with your gifts?

I'm a big believer that every gift counts. I'm not a huge giver, but I've seen the results that a lot of little bits can make a big difference. For example, I used to get upset if someone told me I needed to tip a certain amount. I didn't like people telling me I HAD to give, or I should give. But then I decided that if I'm charitable and generous, it's not because I have to, or because someone tells me to, it's because I want to. And I do want to be generous. I wasn't always that way, but that new approach has changed my life.

What message do you have for people considering making a gift to the Foundation?



YEAR-END WRAP UP

New Trilogy OPTION

Patients at Salem Hospital now have an advanced radiation treatment option available close to home.

The Trilogy linear accelerator offers stereotactic radiosurgery, a non-surgical procedure that delivers precisely targeted radiation at higher doses than previously possible, while sparing healthy tissue.

The precise targeting effectively destroys tumors, and even allows treatment of some tumors that surgeons can't reach. Precision is especially important when a tumor is close to the spinal cord, brainstem or other vital organ.

The Trilogy often reduces complications and can even reduce the number of treatment sessions needed. In the past, patients had to travel to Portland or San Francisco for these procedures.

The Foundation provided \$1.5 million in support of the equipment, which had a total cost of \$4.8 million.

"From the moment we discussed the possibility of obtaining the Trilogy, the Foundation quickly responded to make it happen," said Nancy Boutin, M.D. "They continue to be the go-to organization for supporting the needs of Salem's cancer patients."

Advocates for SANE Program


From watching TV dramas, you may have learned that catching the criminals often depends on the quality of "forensic" evidence gathered by the professionals.

At Salem Hospital, there is also a team of professionals, Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners (SANE), who gather evidence from assault victims brought to the hospital's emergency center.

"Taking care of the medical, as well as the psychological needs of the patient survivor is our first priority," said Mary Crawford-Medina, an emergency room nurse who coordinates the hospital's SANE program. "Simultaneously, we only have one chance to collect evidence from the survivor... and that may mean the difference between a successful or not successful prosecution of the offender," she said.


For the past two years, Salem Hospital has participated in a county-wide Sexual Assault Response Team (SART). They are a

collaborative effort of community partners which includes medical, advocacy, law enforcement and prosecution representatives working in a “survivor-centered perpetrator awareness system.”

With a \$17,500 grant from the Salem Hospital Foundation, Mary and her team were able to not only purchase equipment, but also train 15 Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners. The examiners provide coverage 24-hours a day, seven days a week, at the hospital for victims of sexual assault or rape. “Our goal is to get 30 nurses trained,” she said.

Presently, the hospital sees more than 12 cases of sexual assault a month. However, Mary foresees that number increasing, as staff from the SANE program provide more outreach education to the public.

Before the Foundation grant, the team relied solely on stationary equipment in the emergency center. Now, a mobile cart allows professional collection and securing of evidence in a special processing room. The team was also able to purchase a camera, photo scales, and other evidence gathering tools.

“We are so grateful to the Foundation for their support,” said Mary. “They’ve been great advocates in seeing how important this program is not only for victims of sexual assault, but also for our entire community.”
