Dr. Darus has been the medical director of the gynecologic oncology program at Providence Cancer Institute since 2020 and serves as the physician champion for the new collaboration at Salem Health. He will begin seeing patients for clinic visits in December to support the transition until Drs. Buras and Takimoto arrive.

What does this mean for you as a referring provider?

- There is a 4-6 week window where patients who need surgery in that timeframe will not be able to receive it at Salem Health.
- You may still send your referrals to our clinic and Dr. Darus will be reviewing and triaging each case based on the individual situation.
- Dr. Darus will be providing consultations at Salem Health and taking patients to surgery at Providence as appropriate during this short time.
- Patients will have the option of where they receive their care that may include Providence, Legacy, OHSU, or Willamette Valley Cancer Institute in Eugene.
- We will begin surgery again at Salem Health as soon as the first permanent provider starts with us in January.
- Patients are being made aware of their option to follow their current OHSU physician to Portland for their ongoing care.

Why is Salem Health making this change?

Our goal is to increase access to care that is close to home and provide a care team geographically dedicated to patients in our community. We are looking forward to more local coverage by Dr. Buras and Dr. Takimoto, which will strengthen collaboration between specialties to best support our gynecologic oncology patients.
