	Emergency	 Pick up vehicle up from the valet service in the Oak Street turnaround (either by texting the number on their ticket stub or handing the ticket to the valet). The valet is free and no tips are accepted. Retrieve their own car from the parking garage or other parking lots on campus.
•	Building A inpatient units	 Pick patient up in the parking garage under Building A in the center area marked "patient discharge." This area can be accessed using elevators 5 and 6 (trauma elevators). Oversized vehicles do not fit in this garage. There is no non-handicap patient parking in this garage. Inpatients discharged from Building A can also be discharged out the front of Building B. This is the recommended method for patients who know they will be picked up in an oversized vehicle. If a patient was valeted (admitted through ED, from a surgery, from Building C), discharge them from the Oak St. turnaround.
	Surgery	 If car was valeted from Building C, retrieve car from the valet service in the Building C garage and depart from the Building C parking garage. If the car was valeted at the Oak St. valet, retrieve it from the Oak St. turnaround. 

Mec	Picking up or dropping off in a passenger vehicle Building A (890 Oak St. SE)	 If you are picking up or dropping off a patient for a scheduled visit to Building A, do so in the parking garage under Building A (accessed from Winter St.). The elevators are located on the east end of the garage. If you are dropping off or picking up a patient for the emergency room, drive to the guard house on Oak St. and you will be allowed through the turnaround.
Medical Tran	Picking up or dropping off in a passenger vehicle - Building C (875 Oak St., but the garage is on Winter St.)	 If you are picking up or dropping off a patient for a scheduled visit to Building C, do so in the Building C parking garage (accessed from Winter St.). The patient valets will direct you forward to a safe patient drop-off area.
Transport	Picking up or dropping off in vehicles with 7'6" or greater clearance - Buildings A and C	 If you are picking up or dropping off a patient to Buildings A or C in a vehicle with clearance greater than 7'6", enter the Oak St. turnaround after stopping at the guard house to check in. A limited number of transport vehicles are allowed in the turnaround at any one time. You will be directed to a cellphone staging lot to avoid congestion. Transport vehicles may also pick Building A or Building B patients up at the front of Building B.
