Aspirin: Continue taking aspirin or aspirin-based medications unless your doctor says otherwise.		
Blood Thinning Medications:		
0	Plavix/Clopidogrel: Stop 7 days before surgery. Last dose:	
0	Xarelto/Rivaroxaban: Stop 2, 3, or 5 days before surgery. Last dose:	
0	Eliquis/Apixaban: Stop 2 or 3 days before surgery. Last dose:	
0	Brilinta/Ticagrelor: Stop 5 days before surgery. Last dose:	
0	Pradaxa/Dabigatran: Stop 2 or 3 days before surgery. Last dose:

If you need bridging, the anti-coagulation clinic will contact you.		
Diabetes Medications:		
0	<b>GLP-1 Medications</b> (usually end in " <b>-glutide</b> "): Stop daily doses on the day of surgery or injectable doses the week before.	
0	Medications with "glifozin": Stop 3 days before surgery.	
0	Other oral diabetes medications: Stop on the morning of surgery.	
Immunosuppressants:		
0	Medications ending in "-mab": Skip the dose before surgery.	
0	Methotrexate: Discuss with your provider.	
0	Prednisone: Discuss with your provider.	
0	Transplant/HIV medications: Never skip a dose.	
Narcotics:		
0	Minimize pain medications before surgery.	
0	Do not take narcotics within 24 hours of surgery.	
0	Cannabis/Marijuana: Avoid inhaled or oral pro	oducts (especially THC). Topical use is okay.
